Dear Parent/Carer

As you will be well aware we are now moving into the final build up towards the GCSE examinations and our last weeks on our Wildern journey together. We really want to ensure that our students are getting the best from this time and it is best adapted to appropriately support and challenge them. For this reason we are going to make a few changes to the current registration/tutor time and I wanted to take some time to communicate this with you.

As you know we are constantly monitoring the progress of our students through a range of means, from our WAD to everyday interactions. From this we have identified that it would be worthwhile spending some time working with our students on some exam specific skills to consolidate what they have learnt and give them confidence in this. For this reason we will be allocating targeted sessions with specially allocated grouping and staffing on Friday mornings starting on the 10 March 2023. Examples of these sessions range from additional Maths/English to 'revision techniques' and 'handling the exam period'. The aim of this is to help students in feeling fully prepared for their exams and provide another opportunity to learn skills that will help them in this last part of school and beyond.

As I mentioned, we are keen to ensure that your children, our students are in the best possible place for their GCSE exams and we hope that this will form another part of that.
