Key reminders when selecting your Pathways choices

- All students will continue to study English (English Language and English Literature), Maths, Science, Core PE and Education for Life (EfL).
- All students will study either Geography or History. They must select one.
- The English Baccalaureate (EBacc) is a set of subjects at GCSE that keeps young people's options open for further study and future careers. <u>Students can only achieve this if they've selected a language.</u>
- Students must select three pathways choices in preference order (rank order from 1 to 3)
- We cannot guarantee that students will get all three pathways choices.
- All students must select a reserve choice. This is the subject they will study if one of their 3 choices is not available.

If students select an MFL subject it must be the subject they have studied in Years 7 and 8

Students <u>can</u> select more than one Creative Arts subject. For example Art and Drama. It is important to rank order choices. If a subject is oversubscribed we will give priority to students who picked it as their first choice.

To ensure a broad and balanced curriculum:

Students can select 1 Technology subject: Textiles, OR Foor, OR Wood, Metal and Plastics, OR Hospitality

> If selecting Art, they must choose Fine Art, OR Photography. Students cannot do both.
