





- Student Loans are a massive financial commitment
- Minimum £9,250 per year in tuition fees
- Interest is RPI (Retail Price Index) + 3%, which applies as soon as you get your first payment
- > Compound Loan (so you pay interest on your interest)
- > Repayments are 9% of everything you earn over £27,295
- > Student Loan expires after 30 years

Interest rate is currently 6.3%

No guaranteed job upon conclusion.




The average debt among those who finished studying in 2020 was £45,000

How does an Apprenticeship work?



- A full time job (minimum 30 hours) where your employer is looking to invest in you by developing a specific skill set which will form the basis of your future career (Software Development for example)
- Paid salary whilst working (Earning and Learning) Employment contract, holiday, pension etc...
- Practical training on the job, combined with scheduled modular study
- Work and learn alongside experienced staff (Away from purely classroom learning)
- Gain industry recognised qualifications.
- Progress up to **Degree Level** education
- Funded by the Government and your Employer



Apprenticeship Levels & Entry Requirements

- Level 2 Intermediate Apprenticeship Equivalent to 5 GCSEs (grades 4-9)
- Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship Equivalent to 2 A Levels
- Level 4– Higher Apprenticeship Equivalent to a HND / foundation degree
- Level 5, 6 & 7 Degree Apprenticeship Equivalent to an undergraduate degree / Master's degree

You must have GCSEs in Maths and English with at least grade 4

You must be a year 11 school leaver or older

You can complete a level 2 or level 3 apprenticeship straight from school

Employers are looking for education subjects and/or personal interest in the relevant Apprenticeship standard PETA


