



### **Returning to school from March 8th 2021**

Students will return in a staggered way in order that they receive their first negative test before being back in the classroom.

#### **Guidance to students on coming in for testing**

- Wear a warm coat and bring an umbrella. (You will be waiting outside)
- Follow all instructions carefully
- Maintain social distance rules
- Wear your mask as demonstrated in the video
- Leave the school site immediately after your test and go straight home

**NB: Any students that have not got consent will return to school when their Year Group returns to school the day after their testing e.g Year 11 student will return to school on Tuesday 9th March**
