Re: Year 11 Practice Mathematics Exams March 2022

As part of your son/daughter's preparation for the GCSE Mathematics Exam, they will be sitting adjusted versions of practice exams in their Mathematics lessons in March. To allow us to continue to revise alongside these second set of practice exams, we will be staging these across 3 weeks.

These exams will take place on the following dates:

Paper 1 – Non Calculator – Tuesday 8 and Wednesday 9 March

Paper 2 – Calculator – Wednesday 16 and Thursday 17 March

Paper 3 – Calculator – Tuesday 22 and Wednesday 23 March

The results of these exams will provide students with a more detailed breakdown of the areas they need to focus on in the run up to the real GCSE exams. Students should prepare for them as part of their planned revision. Mathematics clinic continues to run every night after school between 3.00pm – 4.00pm. Students are able to get help with anything they are struggling with, including their practice papers.

Students will need to make sure that they bring the following equipment to all of their Mathematics exams:

- 2 x black pens
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Protractor
- Compass
- Rubber
- Calculator (Paper 2 and 3 only)

Unfortunately, we will be unable to lend any equipment to students, as it is important that they are able to remember to bring this themselves.

Access arrangements, including readers and extra time will be offered to all entitled students.

If your son/daughter has been identified as "Pupil Premium" they will be able to use equipment from our department, which will be supplied at the start of each exam.
