- Persistent punctuality concerns
- Poor or inconsistent attitudes to learning
 - o Persistently not completing self-study on time and to a required standard
 - o Not being appropriately equipped and ready to learn
 - o Not being respectful to teachers and other learners at all times
- Poor attitude grades across subject areas and/or negative EREF scores
- Persistent breaking of the uniform code

We believe that this event is a fantastic opportunity for our students to celebrate with friends and create lasting memories.
