### Year 8 trip to Legoland, Windsor- Thursday 5 June 2025

The Science department would like to offer your child the opportunity to visit Legoland, Windsor. The trip includes entry to Legoland and a 60 minute workshop, focussing on the energy and forces around rollercoasters. The aim of the trip is to provide students with the opportunity to discover and investigate how gravity, friction and weight can affect the speed and distance of rollercoasters. Pupils will work in groups to design, build and evaluate their own LEGO model roller coaster.

The trip will take place on Thursday 5 June 2025. Students will meet at 8:00am in front of the swimming pool by the coach. Students will travel by coach and will leave school promptly at 8.10am and return at approximately 4pm (we will be leaving Windsor at 2:30pm). All students will require a packed lunch and a water bottle. If your child is entitled to a free school lunch, this will be provided for them. Students will be representing the school on this trip so the highest standards of behaviour will be expected. Students are required to wear school uniform.

The cost of a place on the trip is £43.00 which covers tickets to Legoland, the workshop and coach hire costs.

Please complete the parental agreement section online through your ParentPay account to give consent for your child to attend this trip. You will be asked to provide your emergency contact details and any relevant medical information.

If you have been notified that we as a school receive Pupil Premium funding for your child, the cost of this trip will be covered.
