Of course, there is also Amazon for new versions of the texts, but they also sell second hand books, just look for 'used' under the main advertised price.

The following texts are required for your child's study in the summer term:

Year 7

'Twelve Minutes to Midnight' by Christopher Edge. We recommend this version of the text: ISBN 978-0-85763-050-6

Year 8

'Romeo and Juliet' by William Shakespeare - Oxford School Shakespeare edition is good, as is the Cambridge School edition.

As usual, Pupil Premium students will have a copy of each text provided by the school.
