#### When is the prom?

The Wildern School Cosmic Prom will be held on Thursday 22nd July. **Students should aim to arrive from 6pm and must arrive by 7.15pm** to ensure they are seated in time for the meal to be served.

## Where is the prom being held?

The venue for the prom is St Mary's Stadium, Britannia Road, Southampton, SO14 5FP.

## Where should my son/daughter get dropped off?

There will be stewards on the night to direct traffic within the stadium. Cars should head into the North Car Park on Britannia Road, SO14 5RG where they will be directed around the stadium to the South Car Park, and then around to the front of the stadium where they will be able to stop and drop off in front of the red carpet.

# Can I come to watch my son/daughter getting dropped off?

Friends and family are very welcome to watch students being dropped off, please continue to adhere to all Government guidelines and social distancing rules. There will be space on either side of the carpet for spectators. You can park in the stadium's car parks. Cars must be moved from the car parks later in the evening - no overnight parking.

# Do I have to pay for anything on the night?

The price of the prom tickets includes a welcome mocktail along with a three course meal. **St Mary's Stadium is a cashless venue** so if you would like your son/daughter to purchase soft drinks on the night, they will need to bring a debit card or Apple/Google pay.

#### What does the three course meal consist of?

Starter - Giant crostini with grilled Mediterranean vegetables, bocconcini mozzarella on a ciabatta

Main course - 7oz Beef burger served on a brioche bun with lettuce, beef tomato, triple cooked chips and Country slaw

Dessert - Salted caramel and chocolate brownie with candied orange and milk jam Vegetarian and vegan options are available when requested in advance.

#### My son/daughter has dietary requirements, how do I let you know?

If your son/daughter has dietary requirements, please make us aware when you purchase the prom ticket. Alternatively, email Miss Mills on <u>s.mills2@wildern.org</u> before Friday 2nd July to ensure the venue is made aware of this.

## Will there be an opportunity to take a picture in front of the pitch?

Between 6pm and 7.45pm, students will have the opportunity to take a photo in front of the football pitch. Due to security reasons, it will only be possible for this to happen during these times.

## What time does the prom finish?

The prom will end at 11pm so please make arrangements for your son/daughter to be picked up from the stadium car parks at this time.

## Please note, St Mary's is a no smoking venue.

The event is planned after the planned lifting of restrictions on July 19th, therefore St Mary's stadium have informed us that there are no Covid restrictions associated with this event. If St Mary's imposes any of their own restrictions, that we are currently unaware of, then we will let you know as soon as possible.
