

Next week, we will be celebrating British Science Week. As part of Year 7's science lessons, we have planned an opportunity for them to take part in 'Kitchen Chemistry'. If they would like to join in, they will need to have the ingredients for at least one of the experiments below.

Don't worry if you can't get hold of these ingredients, there will be videos of the experiments available for them to watch.

Experiment 1 - Rainbow in a glass Experiment 2 - Milk Explosion 150g sugar Milk Water Dinner plate Four different colours of food Four different colours of food colouring colouring Tablespoon Cotton buds 5 glasses Washing up liquid Experiment 3 - Walking Water Experiment 4 - Lava Lamp 7 glasses Tall bottle or glass Paper towels Cup Food colouring (red, yellow and Vegetable oil blue work best) Food colouring Water Vinegar Baking Soda (3 spoons) Experiment 5 - Oobleck Experiment 6 - Freezing Water 2 cups of cornflour 100ml of cold water 1 cup of water 100ml of hot water Food colouring (optional) 2 cups (that can go in the freezer) A freezer

Experiment 7 - White Flower (ideal mother's day gift!)

- Different colours of food colouring
- White flower (carnations work well but roses will also do)
- Jars or glasses for the flower to stand up in
