This week we are introducing our #it'snotok campaign tag to students in assemblies. The aim of this is to use the hashtag over the year to raise awareness of the issues around sexual harassment, sexual violence, prejudicial behaviours and peer on peer abuse.

This week sees the introduction of the hashtag, and the topic of Harmful Sexual Behaviours.
