I have an exciting opportunity for those of you who are interested in tackling climate change.

The STATWARS® Climate Change Challenge asks you to use data to identify 3 changes you can personally commit to in your daily lives that will lower your individual carbon footprint.

You can work in small teams (this has to be done online) or individually and use your data skills to communicate your commitment to these changes, in the form of a manifesto!

You will need to:

- Design and create a data driven poster, which provides key information for how you came to your decision
- Design and create an advertisement poster/manifesto pledge, which is a creative element where you can explore ways of drawing attention to your ideas for change and encourage others to join you on your journey
- Produce a 60-sec pitch to support you manifesto
- In addition, your 3 commitments to change will each be submitted to a national database in order to support climate change research.

All submitted entries receive a certificate of completion and the winning groups are entered into the final round of judging by our high profile industry judges and overall winners receive an award.

This project will need to be done in your own time but support will be available via Google Classroom and email.
