When joining Wildern, every student is allocated a tutor group that they remain in for their entire journey. This is more than a group that meets to register each morning. It is a busy hub of discussion, a place where students can voice opinions about school and a centre for priceless information about the day to day business of school that runs alongside covering crucial topics that provide 'Education for Life'.
