## Re: Year 7 - The Tempest at Shakespeare's Globe – Friday 17 March 2023

The English department is thrilled to announce that they have secured 70 tickets to watch a performance of *The Tempest* at Shakespeare's Globe Theatre in London. This is the key text students will study in the spring term and the trip is a fantastic opportunity for students to enhance their knowledge of Shakespeare and gain a stronger understanding of his language.

The date of the trip is on Friday 17 March 2023, leaving WIldern School at 9am and returning at approximately 7.30pm. We anticipate that this trip will be very popular, and so would like to open the opportunity to students now, and encourage parents to pay via parent pay as soon as possible.

The cost of the trip will be £45 per student, which covers the costs of the ticket and coach travel.

In the event of a place not being allocated you will be informed and any monies received will be returned.
