## RE: Year 7 - Natural History Museum and London Eye - Monday 30 January 2023

In order to enrich the Geography curriculum and support the teaching of natural hazards, ecosystems and the UK, the Wildern School Geography Department has organised a trip to the Natural History Museum. Students will be able to explore the exhibitions and further their knowledge of many topics that we study during KS3. In the afternoon, students will also be taken on the London Eye to see the human and physical geographical features of London.

The trip will take place on Monday 30 January 2023. **The cost will be £35 per student**. This is to cover the coach hire and the ticket for the London Eye. Students will be supervised by members of the Geography Department at all times.

All students will require a packed lunch and a water bottle. If your child is entitled to a free school lunch, this will be provided for them. Students will be representing the school on this trip so the highest standards of behaviour will be expected. Students are required to wear school uniform.

The coach will leave Wildern School promptly at 8.00am and will return by coach at approximately 6.00pm. **We ask your son/daughter to be at school at 7:45am to meet the coach.** 

Please complete the parental agreement form online through your Parentpay account to give consent for your son/daughter to attend this trip. You will be asked to provide your emergency contact details and any relevant medical information. If a deposit, or full payment, is required this will also need to be paid at the time. If you have not already activated your Parentpay account and require your login details please do not hesitate to contact the Finance Office at <a href="mailto:finance@wildern.org">finance@wildern.org</a>.

If you have been notified that we as a school receive Pupil Premium funding for your son or daughter, the cost of this trip will be covered. If this is the case, your Parentpay account will automatically reflect this but please complete the consent, emergency contact information and medical details through Parentpay as usual. The same procedures regarding oversubscription for the trip will apply.

If you would like your son/daughter to attend please complete the online Parentpay medical and consent forms accompanied by a payment of £35.00 by Wednesday 11 January 2023.

There are 60 places on this trip. In the event of oversubscription we will endeavour to take into consideration any students who may have missed out on trips previously due to oversubscription and will allocate any further places by drawing names out of a hat. In the event of a place not being allocated you will be informed and any monies received will be returned.
