I am pleased to be able to offer your child the opportunity to take part in the following overseas trip in conjunction with Travelbound.

Trip: Day trip to Lille, France Cost per student: £100 Date: Friday 8th July 2022

Mode of travel: Coach & Eurotunnel

Included in this price is:

- Return travel from school via executive coach
- Eurotunnel crossing via the channel tunnel
- A tour of Lille
- Ascent of the Belfry Tower in Lille
- Group insurance

The only additional costs will be spending money for a meal on the return journey. Students will require a packed breakfast/lunch for the outward journey. Students must also be in possession of their own passport and GHIC. If you currently have a valid old EHIC card, this can continue to be used until it expires. Please note that there is currently a delay on new applications for GHIC cards, so early application is advised. More information can be found on the NHS website. The trip will be led by myself in conjunction with Travelbound, a company that Wildern School has worked with for many years undertaking many successful trips abroad. Three other teachers will also accompany the trip.

There are significant benefits to be had from a visit abroad. It affords the opportunity for the students to succeed in a new challenge, enjoying the benefits of increased self-confidence and the forming of new relationships both within their peer group and the wider range of people they will meet on the trip. It also offers a different cultural experience and the opportunity to develop a new awareness and sense of achievement that complements their French learning journey, or indeed any other language.

There are 40 places available on this trip. Due to the trip visiting France, priority will be given to students who study French. In the event of oversubscription after this, places will be allocated by drawing names out of a hat.

You will be asked to provide your emergency contact details and any relevant medical information. If a deposit, or full payment, is required this will also need to be paid at the time.
