

5 Ways to improve the quality of remote learning

It's not just about completing tasks; it is about completing tasks to the highest standard possible for your child. Invite your child to do the following to ensure quality work is always being submitted.



1

Check

Check the task set for the lesson.

Ask: what did you need to do for today's lesson? Have you completed everything you needed to? Can you show me?

2

Proofread

Proofread for spelling, punctuation and grammar mistakes. Proofreading shows that you take pride in your work.

Ask: can you read it aloud to me? Does that make sense? Are you happy with the accuracy of your work?

3

Question

Question the effort that your child has put into their work.

Ask: what will your teacher think of your work today? What percentage effort did you put into it? What impression does it give of you as a student?

4

Upgrade

Upgrade work to be 'exceptional'.

Ask: how could you upgrade the presentation of your work? Were there any extension tasks today? Did you complete them? Are there any vocabulary choices you could upgrade, with the help of a thesaurus?

5

Deepen

Deepen understanding by applying learning in new ways.

Ask: can you teach me what you have learned today? Can you design a quiz to test yourself on this next week? If you had to draw something to represent what you have learned in this subject today, what would you draw and why?
