Re: Year 11 Practice GCSE/Vocational Examinations 2025

Please find attached the GCSE Practice Examination schedule for Year 11. An individual exam timetable will be published soon, including information on rooms and seat numbers, and will also be available via Edulink. The Edulink exam tab also displays exam entries and results for your reference.

These examinations are conducted under full JCQ GCSE exam conditions and are used to ensure that students are fully aware of the conditions and regulations governing public examinations. We welcome your support in ensuring your child approaches them diligently. Failure to follow these rules in the real exams will result in disqualification.

The exam schedule is very tight, so we will suspend the Year 11 timetable from **Monday 3 November, until Friday 14 November 2025, inclusive**. During this time, students only need to be in school for their examinations. If you wish for your son/daughter to remain in school during the week, suitable accommodation will be provided. Students should sign in with a member of staff in the designated room via the LRC.

If needed, we have some catch-up sessions on the 17 and 18 November. Students will begin receiving feedback on these exams from the 24 November. Final results from these exams and a WAD update will be given out at 8am on the 18 December during our Practice results day.

The summer exam schedule is now available, including contingency days, if you haven't already seen it <u>on our website</u>. Students must note the dates and times of their exams and ensure they arrive on time for all examinations. They should be at their examination room <u>at least 10 minutes before the published start time.</u> For example, the doors open and we start seating students at 8:35 am for an 8:45 am start, etc.

For public examinations, students must use **black ink** as the exam papers are scanned and sent electronically to examiners around the country to mark. Would you therefore please ensure that your child has a black pen and all other exam equipment.

As GCSE courses are changing, there has been an increase in the number of linear examinations your child will sit. With the shift towards these exams, it is also important that they know how to prepare for them, including how they revise, practise answering questions and use their independent study time. An exam booklet with further specific exam information will be with you shortly to support this.

We expect that if students are not sitting an examination or working in school, they are at home revising and preparing for their next exam. They should not be in the village or shops around Hedge End. Any students who do not abide by this request will have their exam leave suspended and their normal timetable reinstated. Although these examinations are a practice for students to experience the questions and receive feedback on them, they will also be taken into account if the school is asked to provide a Centre Assessed Grade, as we were for previous Year 11 cohorts 2020 and 2021. Therefore, students should apply themselves to their studies and attempt each exam to the best of their ability.
