## Re: Diphtheria/Tetanus/Polio and Meningitis ACWY vaccinations due in Year 9

Your child is now due their teenage vaccinations as part of the school age immunisation programme. We are due to visit your child's school on **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2023.**

The unique code for your child's school is **SH136654**. When completing the consent form please do not use 'copy and paste' or 'autofill'. Please review and submit your completed form by 10am on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2023 to ensure your child receives their vaccination. When you have submitted your form, you will receive a confirmation email. If you do not receive this email, please contact us.

If you decide you do not wish your child to receive either of these vaccines, please submit the 'no consent' form. This will enable us to update your child's immunisation record.

If your child is absent on the day of the vaccination session, the School Age Immunisation Service will offer a further opportunity for them to receive the vaccines in school.

Protect your child by making sure all their vaccinations are up to date including **Measles, Mumps & Rubella vaccine (MMR).** Measles and Mumps are highly contagious infectious diseases, spread by coughs and sneezes. The MMR vaccination (2 dose schedule) provides the best protection against measles, mumps, and rubella.
